Deposit for electricity should be paid. Unused deposit for electricity is refundable when Card is returned to the Harbour.
- No free Wi-Fi in the Old Castle Harbour, but TEO Wi-Fi "ZEBRA" is available via GSM connection. You can obtain access code via internet https://www.teo.lt/en/about-teo/1406. Telecom webpage in English, accepts payment cards. Better to buy local Prepaid Service SIM card. You should ask somebody's assistance to guide you.
- 6. Internet connection available at Harbour duty premises 24/7 (computer already installed at the premises).
- 7. Other services: local lifting crane up to 8 tons, heavy duty crane might be ordered on request, laundry (washing machine & drying machine), slip service, storage room, restaurant, Pump out station for sewage and oily water.
